All About Art: Digital Design

Students age 12 or older will learn to create a variety of computer generated art work using Adobe Illustrator and Photoshop.
Students will receive a flash drive and all projects will be printed.

Junior Artists Camp (gr. 1/2)

Students from 1st-2nd grades will create both 2D and 3D age appropriate projects. There will be a visiting artist, and a visit to the Brauer Museum with a docent which will enable us to see art by the masters.

Students from grades 6- adult will be immersed in fabrics, wool, felt, and other fibers, during 1 week of classes from 5:00pm-6:30pm each weekday. There will be a visiting artist, and a visit to the Brauer Museum with a docent which will enable us to see art by the masters.

Sculpture Camp

Students from 3rd-5th grades will be immersed in creating sculptures during 1 week of classes from 9am-Noon each weekday. We will use clay, concrete, plaster, plastic, metal, sand, and cardboard to create a variety of 3-D art. We will experience a visiting artist and visit the Brauer Museum with a docent to see masters' sculptures and be inspired by the same. We will meet one morning at Hot Shop Valpo to experience the art of glass blowing and then walk to Jessee-Pifer Park where we use found objects from nature to create on site.

Special Needs Camp

Students who need special attention while creating art, but don't need a one-on-one Para at all times will experience a variety of art mediums and inspirations while creating their own art.

Painting/Drawing Camp

Students from 3rd-5th grades will be immersed in drawing and painting during 1 week of classes from 9am – noon each weekday. We will use charcoal, pastels, oil pastels, pencils, watercolor, and acrylics to create 1 point perspective landscape, contour drawing, still life, and other themed paintings of the student's choice, on canvas and paper. We will have one plein air painting day at Rodgers Lakewood Park to create landscapes on site. There will be a visiting artist, and a visit to the Brauer Museum with a docent which will enable us to see art by the masters.



Advanced Camp

Students from 4th grade or older will learn classic drawing techniques and explore color theory through painting as they create their works of art. Students will be divided into groups according to age.

The students' experiences will culminate in an art exhibit at the Valparaiso University Center for the Arts.
